CC.Department Reports

1. Fire Dept Report

Chief Nieves: We had a total of 356 reports for the year, 99,385 came in from Hidalgo County. Our training for the Fire Dept has been limited due to Covid 19.

2. Police Dept Report

Quintana: 89 citations issued in 2019 for month of November and we have 74 for this year for month of November so we are slightly right under that number **John**: What are we compared to numbers from last year as compared to this year. Where are we at now. **Quintana:** That information I did not get. I don't have an yearly comparison of the citations. But I can go ahead and get that. **Hugo:** I believe there is a huge difference from last year

3. Engineer Report

Eddie Saenz: Several items we have been doing in the past 30 days is two weeks ago we met with County Of Hidalgo Pct 1 on there possible participation on the Community Center Parking lot. We met there on site and showed them the area and gave them all the quantities. They are going to come up with an estimate. And then prepare an agreement for whichever cost it would take, which would obviously be less than what a general contractor would charge. So we are looking at saving money there. And we are also doing surveys for the Bell Property donation. We are also looking at relocating that ditch that is right next to that property. So it can be relocated to the school property. So once we can come up with that ditch and convert it into a retainage pond. Hugo: When can we present to the school so we can have something a bit more realistic. Eddie: Somewhere around three weeks. Also in conjunction with Hollis Rutledge, submitting the GLO project for the construction of the Waste Water Treatment Plant. We also submitted some money for upgrading the lift station. It came out to something like 4.5 million, we should know if we qualify and made it on the list by around March. We have also been talking to the Urban County street program. We are looking at overlays at Los Laureles and C V Mendez and Hinojosa street and KiKa De La Garza, so hopefully we will be able to get going on that. Mayor: Eddie real quick, what is the status of phase 2 of the overlays you guys did in September? Eddie: The ones we are short on would be Cochran and Crenshaw, Urban County is still doing the envirormentals on those. So once they get cleared then they will give us the go ahead. The funds are still there. And that's all I have.

DD. Presentation by Mr. Paul Villarreal Tax Assessor Collector on 2019-2020 tax collection report

Paul Villarreal: Mayor and Alderman it is an honor to be here through zoom. Tab #1 from Oct 1 2019 to Sept 1, 2020 the tax collection consists of current, delinquent and rollback taxes. A total collected for the City of Edcouch for 608,062.63 the rest is the attorney fees and disbursements and collections. The next page is the breakdown of the 2019 current taxes. Last year base amount was 504,000.16 this year it was 516,000.00. We collected an additional 11,850. Considering the

pandemic I was thinking it was going to be a little bit harder, but we got it done. I can tell you that the tax statements went out the last week of October, so we are working hard and trying to accommodate with our people. I know this pandemic has been hard on everybody. But we will be able to work with the people if they need to work in payments. **Mayor:** Do you have any recommendations on how we can help you with the tax collections. **Paul Villarreal:** Well you know and I m glad you asked that I want to congragulate City Manger Mr. Hugo De La Cruz and offcourse his assistant Manny Hernandez for the great leadership they provide. They are always out there trying to see how they can improve this in order how we can reach out to the city taxpayers. If someone comes up to you send them over to me and we will go ahead and help them out. The elderly that have over 65 exemptions some of them we can work with them. We can put them in quarterly payments, without paying penalties. **Hugo:** Mr. Villarreal I would like to ask a question as what we are going right now as far the pandemic, what is the tax office doing to prepare for the pandemic. **Paul:** I have been here since 1985, what I have been doing all this time is preparing for the tax payer, we had some taxpayers who got there stimulus and came to pay there taxes instead of spending them elsewhere.

Hugo: Mayor this is the item tht Mr. Saenz was talking about. After doing some research we found that that particular ditch run right by Bell s Property. That property belongs to the city now. **Mayor** What property is this? **Eddie**: If I may Mayor, this property is located just east of Ybarra Elementary, it was no use to him. That's when we got his number and Mr. Hernandez called him and this is the perfect time of the year because donating 1.5 acres is a perfect tax write off for 2020 right before the end of the year. So I think it benefits everybody. **Mayor:** What is the land value? **Hugo:** We sent him a receipt for 10,000.

We also changed the front entry doors to automatic doors. The fire marshall had asked us to change the fire department connection from the outside wall to be a pre standard structure that comes out of the ground so the fire department can be further away from building when connecting. Then we had some credits because we changed and the flooring and tile. This brings a total of 34,000. We are almost done, it should be done by the end of the year. Virgil: With change orders are we still in budget? Hugo: Mayor, total project, yes, there was changes that were Covid basically when Covid came in we made some adjustments with the projects, we are waiting for some funding to come in everything has been submitted to the county from the Cares Act.
